



English for Refugees and Asylees (ERA)

Who is eligible? Any refugees, SIVs, asylees, and parolees from certain countries who have been granted status within the last five years, and are living in Maryland.

What documents do I need to register?

1.Proof of immigration status, such as employment authorization card, I-94 2.Proof of residency, such as a lease agreement or a utility bill
